

- The above trustees are trustees initially, Sr.M. Mary Jimsy 11. shall be the president of the Trust. Trustees are jointly entitled to carry on and manage the entire activities of the Trust subject to the control of the Board of Trustees.
- A trustee shall cease to be in office with immediate effect on her becoming insolvent or insane or on being convicted for any offences involving moral turpitude and such other conditions decided from time to time or when person becomes incapable of following the objects of Trust. Any vacancy occurring in the office of the Trustees shall be filled by 2/3 rd majority of the Board.
- 13. The trustees may from time to time delegate to any one of them or to any other person or Committee, such of powers and duties, as they deem fit, subject to retaining the ultimate control and supervision.
- The trustees should meet as often as necessary provided at least, one meeting is held every 3 months. The quorum shall be personal attendance of at least 3 trustees. decisions of the Trust, unless expressly provided otherwise, shall be by simple majority. The chairman of the meeting shall be entitled to a casting vote in the event of equality of votes at the meeting.
- The trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of all 15. receipts and payments and dealings in regard to the Trust property and shall also maintain a correct record of their meeting and deliberations.
- Any trustee can be removed from office before the expiration of their term if their views, activities and life are against the ideals of the trust and are thus prejudicial to interests. Such removal should by a 2/3rd majority of Board of Trustees.
 - 17. Bank accounts may be opened for the Trust in such banks the Board of Trustees decide from time to time. accounts shall be operated jointly by the President and Treasurer of the Trust.
 - 18. The trustees shall have and may exercise all such powers, as in their opinion, shall enable them to effectively carry out all or any of the Trust purposes withour prejudice, In general the foregoing trustees shall have the power:
